

POLICY 7.3 (NAG 6)

UNIFORMS POLICY

RATIONALE:

When children are dressed in school uniform (our 'sports uniform') it creates a feeling of belonging, and pride in their school as well as promoting the school.

PURPOSE:

- Increasing pride in Tokomaru School.
- Enable easy recognition of pupils when representing the school.
- Developing positive image of school.
- Promoting Tokomaru School.

GUIDELINES:

1. It is compulsory for pupils representing Tokomaru School to wear the 'sports uniform' (red/black polo t-shirt & black shorts) when on class day trips (where appropriate), interschool sports days, or any other interschool activities. (Pupils may wear black pants/leggings/skirts/long sleeve black thermal at the Principal's discretion).
2. Students will be issued with a t-shirt & shorts on or before the day they are needed. These need to be returned to the office at the completion of the day (or as soon after as practicable).
3. All new enrolments will be required to purchase a school sunhat when they first start.
4. When overnight trips, camps or associated day trips are involved, it will be expected that the children will wear the school sunhat / black school cap. This will be at the discretion of the teacher in charge.
5. New parents to the school will be informed of this policy prior to their children starting school.
6. The school will have access to a supply of red/black polo t-shirt & black shorts, as well as a limited number of school jackets, for students to borrow as needed.
7. Any lost or damaged 'sports uniform' item will be charged to the student's parents.
