POLICY 7.3 (NAG 6)



UNIFORMS POLICY

RATIONALE:

When children are dressed in school uniform (our 'sports uniform') it creates a feeling of belonging, and pride in their school as well as promoting the school.

PURPOSE:

- Increasing pride in Tokomaru School.
- Enable easy recognition of pupils when representing the school.
- Developing positive image of school.
- Promoting Tokomaru School.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. It is compulsory for pupils representing Tokomaru School to wear the 'sports uniform' (red/black polo t-shirt & black shorts) when on class day trips (where appropriate), interschool sports days, or any other interschool activities. (Pupils may pants/leggings/skirts/long sleeve black thermal at the Principal's discretion).
- 2. Students will be issued with a t-shirt & shorts on or before the day they are needed. These need to be returned to the office at the completion of the day (or as soon after as practicable).
- 3. All new enrolments will be required to purchase a school sunhat when they first start.
- 4. When overnight trips, camps or associated day trips are involved, it will be expected that the children will wear the school sunhat / black school cap. This will be at the discretion of the teacher in charge.
- 5. New parents to the school will be informed of this policy prior to their children starting school.
- 6. The school will have access to a supply of red/black polo t-shirt & black shorts, as well as a limited number of school jackets, for students to borrow as needed.
- 7. Any lost or damaged 'sports uniform' item will be charged to the student's parents.
